What is the Legacy Plan?

The Legacy Plan is the final stage of Vision 2020, and is a school building project designed to bring all of our school buildings into the 21st century:

- Construction of new Upper Elementary School at State Street School (Grades 3-5)
- Conversion of Dunn's Corners and Springbrook to Early Childhood Lower Elementary School (Grades PK-2)
- Elimination of overutilization of Middle School by returning 5th grade to new upper elementary
- Replacement of heating and ventilation systems at Ward and Babcock and auditorium upgrades at Ward
- District-wide safety, security, environmental control, and technology improvements
